
Vintage Racing Club of BC Meeting Minutes

President's Report

Update of the VRCBC and BCHMR web sites now complete



Vice President's Report

Paul noted his work with the local Toyo rep is not a productive as expected. Some smaller tire sizes will be available but the discounts are not as in previous years.

Paul had Tedd speak to the need for submissions to the Nominating Committee for new Board members.

Paul also noted that he will not be the Chair for the 2019 BCHMR and volunteers are needed.

Treasurer's Report

The **BCHMR** was quite successful giving us approximately \$8,000 dollars in the black, of which \$6,360 dollars was received from sponsors.

The **Gala** has never been a 'break even' event in the past years. This year was no exception. It was not as well attended as we had hoped, and the costs were a bit higher this time. There was no wine on the tables this year and all of the door prizes were donations. There were 2 'no shows'. Our expense was \$5,170 dollars; our income was \$3,345 dollars leaving us with a **loss of \$1,825**. Last year our expenses were \$4,910, income was \$3650 dollars and a loss of \$1,260 dollars.

With all of our large bills paid for 2018, we currently have a bank balance of **\$21,181.70**. Last year at this time the balance was \$20, 736.

Membership Report

Mike previously reported that we have 101 members comprised of;

- Life members 8
- Regular members 42
- Family members 32
- New members 2018 19

Recommendation tabled that we should increase dues into 2019 to \$60.00 single membership and a similar \$5 increases for family to \$70.

Competition Director's Report

Dennis reported that VRCBC members are incident free, based on official data. Infractions are occurring at surrounding venues, most are regards ignoring flags and collisions.

He also noted that he was working with Tom to update the eligibility rules for open wheel. He hoped to have a submission ready for our January 15 2019 meeting whereby we had one month to review and comment prior to a vote at the February meeting.

CACC Vintage Discipline

John Elliott has graciously volunteered to take over this seat from Roger and was elected at the recent Vintage Discipline meeting. He is also looking for support from Larry Sandham was elected as Assistant, both who will be looking at the open wheel rules with Dennis.

Those of us who attended the recent Ross Bentley Driving Faster session were treated to a great day of learning. All came away with a much better understanding of our potential!!! (Those who were unable to attend said they will be looking forward to evidence of this during the 2019 season!)

SCCBC Update

There were 20 volunteers at the recent track work party, tasks included maintenance and cleanup as well as tire wall prep.

SCCBC will be using some of their significant bank balance to pave portions of the entrance way.

2019 is an anniversary year for Mission and those that remember INDY events, SCCBC is planning events around this theme.
