CACC Vintage Discipline

John reported on the November 15 CACC annual meeting: the Vintage Discipline accepted our VRCBC 2021 eligibility rules and the updated CACC Vintage rules were approved as submitted, budget requests included \$1000 for promotion (as in 2020), \$400 for Women in Motor Sport and submission for travel reimbursements.
