Director at Large Report: (Brett Payne)

Not much to report, but found it confusing on MSR to have his FF registered as vintage on SCCBC weekends. It
was confirmed that any VRCBC member entered in an open wheel class on the Sunday of a SCCBC/CACC
weekend collects points in the REVS series, and could conceivably collect points in their class for SCCBC & CACC
championship as well.

CACC report:

- From Stanton Via Email:
 - No Discipline Directors' meeting in July. The next one is August 12. I was asked by the steward (John Gillespie) after the CACC #3 meeting where to find the current VRCBC Vintage eligibility rules. I explained that they are always on the VRCBC website. I am going to drop a hard copy off at Race Control for the steward(s) for CACC #4.
 - Just as an FYI, apparently, there has been some concern about rough driving among some of the Race (not Vintage) Discipline drivers as a result of the incidents during CACC #3. I have heard nothing official.
 Maybe someone else at the meeting can comment?
 - There was some discussion about aggressive driving in other classes, where significant body contact occurred. CACC is trying to curtail this in all classes and race groups. A reminder that we have zero tolerance for body contact in Vintage.
 - o Sunday morning Vintage Drivers' Meeting seems to be working well.

SCCBC Report:

• SCCBC is doing video clips of its race weekends this year, which are being posted online. Should VRCBC make a video for promotional purposes for the BCHMR? They are being done by of Mark Moser, who's a track photographer and videographer. We wanted to not only use the videos to promote the club and racing this year, but also for years to come. META Report:

BCHMR Report: (Gayle Baird)
