### The Midona Special

The Midona was a special built by Dr. Russell and Roy Shadbolt and featured a custom tubular chassis, Devin-style fibreglass body, supercharged Skoda engine, and Morris Minor suspension, brakes, and steering.

Hence "Minoda".

After the Skoda engine detonated spectacularly, Ray Nelson bought the car and installed a 2½ litre Riley twin cam from a DHC



that had been wrapped around a hydro pole at the southwest exit from the Burrard Street Bridge. There was a gas station there in the 60s, and the poor Riley sat there for quite some time before Ray bought it for parts.

I was picking up MG parts from Dave Price at British Car Parts on Marine Drive in North Vancouver when I saw a "for sale" ad with a photo of the car and a location in the British Properties. At that time, it was red with two white racing stripes. No doors and a side-mounted exhaust system with a quick-release muffler. Seats were fibreglass lawn seats with the legs cut off, bolted through the floor.

I took it apart, re-engineered everything and entered many gymkhana and slaloms with some success. Had to have Vancouver Cold Welding perform expensive remedial work on the engine block, which had become porous.

I painted it metallic blue with white stripes and ran it at Westwood, but the brakes weren't up to the weight and speed, so I had some frightening moments.

I eventually sold it to Ian Martin, my Rally Navigator, who blew the Riley engine up in spectacular fashion. He sold it to a chap in East Van who planned to install an MGB engine, but the car then vanished. I hope it still exists, tucked away in a dusty garage somewhere?
