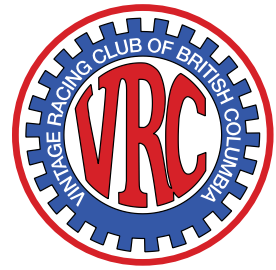

DIRECTOR AT LARGE – Brett Payne

I will be working the Auto Show (VIAS) on Friday and Saturday and will be volunteering at the Driver’s Training event at Mission on Sunday, March 29th. Looking forward to meeting the students and sharing information on VRCBC with them. Free membership in VRCBC will be included in the driver packages.

DIRECTOR AT LARGE – Keith Robinson

Nothing to report at this time.

CACC REPORT – Stan Guy (Vintage Discipline Director)

- The Eligibility Rules for the upcoming season have been updated with date changes only.
- Stan plans to collaborate with John Edwards, the new Chief Scrutineer, to streamline and clarify the rules. We need to form an Eligibility Committee.
- Kees Nierop raised a concern about the eligibility of cars from Area 27 (ORRA 27 Okanagan Road Race Association) and expressed interest in discussing its recognition as a group within the vintage club. Discussion took place regarding allowing ORRA 27 license holders to compete in VRCBC races, with Kees confirming that Area 27 senior race license holders can now race at Mission after purchasing a VRCBC membership and completing one observed race. They are FIA approved.
- Stan clarified that while safety and car preparation rules are covered under CACC vintage rules, the eligibility committee can consider other organizations' cars if they meet age requirements.

BCHMR – Gayle Baird

- Plans are progressing
- Mike has promo material ready for pick up, to be handed out at the VIAS.
- Promo cards will also be going to Knox, in May with the W.I.M. group.
- Our committee meeting for this month will be cancelled because we are too busy with the VIAS and Driver Training.

SCCBC REPORT – Keith Robinson

Keith reported that paving work at the track is delayed due to weather, with only minimal progress made on Turn 3. Turn 1 is complete and Turn 3 has its first layer of tarmac. Work is still needed between Turns 1 and 2 and around Turn 2 into 3.

Keith expressed concerns about the effectiveness of the current drainage efforts.

Rob Fraser has developed a plan for Driver's Training that will either use a new tire wall path or an alternative route through Turns 4 – 5, if conditions are poor.

The CACC Officials Discipline meeting will be held on ZOOM, March 18th at 7 p.m., followed by the CACC Vintage Discipline meeting on March 18th at 8 p.m.

We plan on opening up our Clubhouse on the Saturday of Driver Training.
