The Triple-O wagon will not be coming to any more race weekends, due to lack of revenue. SCCBC is looking at other options.

BCHMR (Tom)

We will be trying to “manufacture history” by rebranding some SCC trophies for the HMR. The “Index of Performance” award from the 1971 enduro will be rebranded the “Westwood Trophy,” and will go to the winner of the CCGP. The 1960 Castrol award will be rebranded the “Abbotsford Trophy,” and will be awarded to the winner of the FV race. The “Pete Lovely” award will be rebranded as a race-commentator's pick in the exhibition class. And there will be an “SCCBC Award” given to someone in the production-based vintage class.
