CACC Vintage Discipline

Roger commented that the various regulation revisions were accepted / passed at the recent CACC Vintage Discipline meeting. Replicar cars were also discussed at this meeting.

Noted that there is inconsistent interpretation of safety harness expiry dates, apparently the SCCA (and possibly SOVREN) has accepted which are older than the manufacturer's expiry date. The ASN and CACC have confirmed that under no circumstances will they accept harnesses older than the manufacturer's expiry date.

CACC is working on a joint Spec Miata series with WCMA for this season; but not for vintage.

SCCBC Update

At their AGM, current executive was all re-elected. They decided to transition their primary executive positions to two year, with half being elected each year.

- Area 27 is holding their Grand Opening June 2-3 2017. Dennis and Tom are leading our ongoing discussions with Area 27. Dennis commented that there have been issues with their sanctioning for Race Driver Training but Mike Kaerne feels these will be resolved soon. The current plan is for 20 minute sessions available for us, with CACC Lapping (Passing) rules to apply. This is a 3 mile course with a very fast straight, with the current lap record of 2:08 minutes. Dennis and Tom confirmed that regular REVS supporters are to be given first option to attend.
